After an excellent dinner, we viewed Jim's DVD's for the 800 S. Patton Ct. (Ali and Kamila) current House on Patton Court, completed, but not yet occupied. Very frustrating for Ali and Kamila –not known why they cannot move in yet, and as it sits vacant, vandalism occurs on the property!

Treasurer Reports passed around:

We are approximately \$13,000 short of our goal of \$85,000.

Some loose checks turned in to Cynthia who gave them to Julia.

Stan reports \$700 more should be downtown and asks that Julia check into this.

New Hope will have \$1000 before end of year

Smoky Hill Vineyard will have \$5000 before end of year

1<sup>st</sup> Plymouth will have \$500 before end of year

Coins remaining to be turned in approx \$785 from Park Meadows will be counted toward next year's house, as they are not yet cleaned and will be turned in to close to the end of the year for a quick turn-a-round.

Stan asks if we can have a separate accounting of checks being turned into the Malls (from coins being cleaned). These funds need to be tracked somehow, so we can see how much money was sent to HFHI and eventually how much is returned to L&F. We will ask Julia and Carol, downtown, if Carol can consolidate the information we pass to them via email before mailing the checks to the malls.

Fund raising ideas bantered about: Barb suggests a Sunday School Missions Class be initiated in each of our churches! Great idea! It would bring more attention to members of each congregation as to what we are doing if there was a six week course in Habitat for Humanity/Loaves & Fishes, say.

Cynthia reports \$510 was raised from the Habitat & ALL That JAZZ concert on Oct. 22<sup>nd</sup> 6 Jazz Musicians entertained 34 attendees.
